national regulations for teaching and research positions and recruitment positions.

The Ministry of Education has established regulations for teaching and research positions and recruitment positions. The regulations will come into effect simultaneously with the new Universities and Colleges Act on August 1, 2024.

- The most important changes for early-stage researchers, are:
- Instead of "Duty-work" the term now established is Career development activities. The definition in the act is: *Other **career development activities** refers to activities beyond research and education that provide relevant knowledge and experience for advancing career paths at higher education or research institutions, or in other sectors.*
- Both Ph.D. and postdocs shall be offered a **career development plan**
- The requirement to master Norwegian language at a minimum **level of B2** to be recognized as competent in teaching and research positions. PhD candidates and postdoctoral fellows shall, if necessary, be offered and complete Norwegian language training equivalent to **15 credits**.
